
Ruth has been busy this week stitching up this cute Cottage Charm table runner with these wonderful spring pastels. We have kits available too.

Basic Grey designed these beautiful Christmas pieces called Evergreen. Sandy loved it so much she sewed up this darling little table runner in one afternoon using the pattern Sew Simple Runner from Martingale.
